

Email from Steve Pennycook of Simon James Homes received on 6<sup>th</sup> December 2017.

Dear Alan,

With regard to the early arrival of haulage wagons on Tuesday 5th December 2017.

Our haulage contractor has been informed of the curfew times at our site in Church Lane, East Harptree, verbally and by email which I will forward to you.

On Tuesday four wagons turned up early despite our previous instructions. Rather than send them away back down Church Lane to park up by the lakes, I thought it more sensible to let them on site to free up the road.

The vehicles were loaded but were not allowed to leave the site until after 09.30am.

Today will be the last day of bulk excavation removal and although there will be times during the project, where we have to remove spoil from site, it will not be on the scale of the previous four days.

I have spoken to some of the neighbours and explained what happened.

We endeavour to work with our neighbours and are doing all we can to reduce the impact on the village and reduce the vehicle movements to a minimum.

Please accept our apologies in this instance and our assurance that it will not happen again.
